## **Education Support Worker (1.0 FTE)**

Through a dynamic new program launch, Jewish Child and Family Service in partnership with Winnipeg Child and Family Services is currently seeking a qualified individual to fill the fulltime role of **Education Support Worker**. Providing direct one-on-one support to students in the care of or continuing to be supported by Winnipeg Child and Family Services, and working as part of a multi-disciplinary team, the **Education Support Worker** assists students with a variety of tasks aimed at realizing educational goals.

Jewish Child and Family Service (JCFS) is a client-centred non-profit social service agency, located in Winnipeg, Manitoba, offering a wide variety of supports including (but not limited to) Older Adult Services, Mental Health and Addictions Services, Child and Family Services, and Settlement.

### **The Role:**

- Collaborate as part of a multi-disciplinary team to improve educational outcomes for CFS involved youth/young adults
- Daily interaction with youth/young adults attending high school or pursuing post-secondary studies, supporting the completion of tasks and goals as part of an individual academic success plan
- Facilitate or assist with transportation of youth to/from school as part of an individual academic success plan
- Provide resource information, and act as an advocate for youth as needed/upon request
- Provide mentorship to support youth/young adults in the development of life skills, including skills related to education and employment
- Assist students with completing/submitted applications for post-secondary study, and post-secondary funding opportunities
- Provide career exploration support, and other individualized supports as needed

### **Your Fit:**

- Post-secondary study in the Child and Youth Care field preferred, or individuals with Grade 12 and two-years' relevant experience will be considered
- Experience working with youth from diverse cultural and social backgrounds
- Effective interpersonal skills to develop positive working relationships with students, colleagues and stakeholders
- Empathetic, mindful, dedicated and able to connect with youth and young adults
- Experience working from a trauma-informed perspective
- Excellent problem solving and decision-making skills
- Strong time management and organizational skills

- Flexible availability Monday through Friday, as needed, to accommodate student appointments and activities outside of standard school hours
- Strong written and verbal communication skills
- Ability to work independently, and as part of a team
- Proficiency with MS Office applications (Word and Outlook)
- Have and able to maintain a valid Manitoba Class 5F Driver's license, with access to a vehicle. An acceptable driver's abstract is also required.
